## 2020 Extension Master Gardener Training Course

**Residents of Knox and surrounding counties are invited to participate in the 2020 UT/TSU Knox County Master Gardener volunteer training!**

The Extension Master Gardeners of Knox County is an award-winning volunteer organization comprised of gardening enthusiasts who are very passionate about gardening, volunteering, and educating in their community while serving the University of Tennessee and Tennessee State University Extension.

The training course will be held every Wednesday morning from 9am to 12pm starting on February 5<sup>th</sup> and ending on May 13<sup>th</sup>, 2020 at the Extension Eastern Region office located at 1801 Downtown W. Blvd. Knoxville, TN 37919. Topics include Basic Botany, Plant Disease Management, Soils, Fruit and Vegetable Gardening, Organic Gardening, and more!

After completing the training course, participants are required to complete 40 hours of volunteer service in Knox County (out of county residents may do half of the hours in their county of residence) and 8 hours of continued education.

**The cost of the course is \$150 if paid on or before the early registration deadline of November 1<sup>st</sup> or \$175 if paid by November 15<sup>th</sup>.** The registration fee includes all training materials and is due *after* your application has been approved. **This course will be limited to 40 people.**
